




Q3 What applications do your students use?




Q5 How do you set up student accounts for digital applications?




Q6 On a scale of 1 to 5, with 1 being "never" and 5 being "very often" How often are your students using more than one app at a time?



Q7 On a scale of 1 to 5, with 1 being "not important" and 5 being "very important" How important is it for parents to have access to their child's digital apps and materials?






Q9 What devices do your students use in the classroom?




